

Faith Christian School Financial Aid Program

It is the intention of the Trustees of Faith Christian School to provide a financial aid program for families in financial need who want to enroll their qualified and accepted children.

Our program is based on the scriptural principle of tithing. We have instituted a Financial Aid Program that is funded through 10% of the receipts for tuition.

Financial Aid is awarded according to the merit and need of each applicant, monies available, class placement and category priorities. Financial Aid does not cover the applicable school fees and generally covers only part of the tuition with a maximum of 50%.

Students who receive aid must remain in good standing to continue. **Financial Aid is not automatic from year to year and must be applied for each year.** No assurances are given that approval will be granted for the next year.

Accreditation/Certification

Faith Christian School is accredited by and a member of the **Association of Christian Schools International** (ACSI), which is the largest Christian school accrediting organization in the world. The State of Texas does not directly accredit private schools. Rather, the Texas Education Agency has a committee, the Texas Educational Private School Accrediting Committee (TEPSAC), which recognizes accrediting agencies. ACSI is recognized as a proper accrediting agency by TEPSAC. **Faith received full accreditation status in May, 2004.** Faith Christian School is also accredited by the **Southern Association of Colleges and Schools** Council on Accreditation and School Improvement (SACSCASI).

The strength of any school is its teachers. At Faith, we look for teachers who are fully committed to Jesus Christ and feel a call to teach here. They must have a four-year degree from a recognized school. Faith Teachers have ACSI certification, Texas or other state certifications.
